A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM FOR THE PUEBLO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO INCLUDE THE 2023 COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION AND MITIGATION OPTIONS FUND, CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (MMOF-ARPA-SLFRF) GRANT OF \$200,000 INTO FY 22-23 BUDGET AND THE INCLUSION OF AREAS OF PERSISTENT POVERTY PROGRAM, AN FTA-D-AOPP-10 GRANT TO BE INCLUDED IN SAID PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Pueblo Area Council of Governments (PACOG), as the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and Transportation Planning Region (TPR) for the Pueblo area in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 134(b); and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, PACOG, Colorado Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration and Federal Highway Administration have mutually agreed to the consolidation, and distribution formula and associated with these grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the PACOG as the Metropolitan Planning Organization wishes to amend the FY 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PUEBLO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS that the Unified Planning Work Program for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 is amended as follows:

## **SECTION 1:**

The FY 2022-2032 UPWP is hereby amended to include the MMOF-ARPA-SLFRF Grant of \$200,000 in the UPWP budget.

## SECTION 2:

The FY 2022-2032 UPWP is hereby amended to include the addition of a new program, 2244 Areas of Persistent Poverty, to improve transit services in areas experiencing long-term economic distress.

## SECTION 3:

The Chair of the PACOG Board is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement.

## **SECTION 4**:

The staff of the City of Pueblo Urban Transportation Division is directed and authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with the intent of this Resolution to effectuate the policies and procedures described herein.
